

**USE OF ANTI – VEGF AGENTS : ECHS BENEFICIARY**

1. Please refer our letter No B/49762/AG/ECHS dated 19 Aug 2013 and 06 Dec 2013.
2. A clarification was asked from consultant Ophthalmology, Army Hospital R&R on use of Anti VEGF Agents for ECHS beneficiaries. It is clarified that more than three Injections of Inj Lucentis may be given if recommended by the treating Ophthalmologist with justification.
3. Inj Aflibercept (inj Eyelea) has not been cleared by Drug Controller General of India (DCGI) and the same will be considered on its approval for its use in India.
